**1. HEY! ♥ prayer weeks:** It is always a privilege to be involved in a **prayer week** similar to those held at **Somerset West Primary** and **Danie Ackermann**. There is a great need for these “**boiler rooms**” where children can come to pray or to bring prayer requests! In Colossians 3:13 Jesus teaches us that we should forgive as He forgave. It is always remarkable how actively the areas where children can forgive others are visited during this week. We can definitely learn from them and be freed from the chains of unforgiveness and bitterness. **There IS so much power in prayer.**

**2. BIBLES.** HEY! Was privileged to receive **donations for Bibles** and could purchase Bibles for those children who would not otherwise have the good fortune of owning one. May **Psalm 119.105** be true for these children and may they grow to love the Word of God. Just look at the photos: **joy of your own Bible!** We teach them how to use the Bibles and to search for and underline memory verses. The enthusiasm with which this is done is fantastic!

**3. Our volunteers are our greatest asset...**

HEY! realises this, as well as the importance of spiritual growth and motivating each other. Every term we try to organise training or a motivational talk where we build up the people who so selflessly offer of their time, love and so much more in serving children. Currently there are **more than 70 volunteers involved in Bible classes in the Cape**. In September Hein Reyneke of SCAS taught us of “**PRAY-PLAY-SAY**” in terms of Colossians 4:2-6 “**CONTINUE earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ.....that I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak. Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming**

the time. Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each other.” From this we learnt **1. PRAY-** for each other and for open doors. **2. PLAY-** be wise in the way in which you treat children/others. **3. SAY-** speak in love (vs 6).
